The City of Bishop Department of Public Works periodically hires engineering and GIS student interns. Pay is low but work experience is excellent.

Bishop Public Works is responsible for streets, water, sewer, building inspection and permits, and most planning in the City of Bishop. The City of Bishop has a permanent population of about 3,500 and is located in the Eastern Sierra, a remote rural part of the State of California. The City's economic base is mostly recreation and government. There are about 10 employees in Public Works.

In addition to regular operations, Public Works is responsible for about \$1 million of street improvements and \$350,000 of each of water and sewer improvements each year. The City's Geographic Information System (GIS) is basic but well developed and is under continuous improvement.
