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## **Public Works News Release**

### **Road Project A Information Meeting**

There will be a meeting at 6:30 pm on Tuesday, December 9, 2008 in the City of Bishop Auditorium at the northeast corner of West Line Street and Fowler Street to discuss the project known as Road Improvement Project A. Anyone interested in the proposed street improvements on Short Street, North Third Street and East Elm Street should attend this meeting.

The Short Street portion of Project A is located between South Second Street and South Third Street and will make improvements to the street including new pavement, curb and gutter, planter strips, cross gutters, driveway entrances, and disabled accessible sidewalks and curb ramps. Two concepts will be presented for Short Street. One concept considers creating a one-way street with diagonal parking. The other concept is the standard two-way street with parallel parking on both sides. There will be an exhibit map showing a schematic of the proposed improvements for both concepts which will include locations and widths of new driveway entrances and total number of parking spaces.

The Third Street portion of Project A is located between East Pine Street and East Elm Street and may include a portion of East Elm Street, if funding allows. This project will make improvements to the street including new pavement, curb and gutter, planter strips, cross gutters, driveway entrances, and disabled accessible sidewalks and curb ramps. Two concepts will be presented. One concept considers the use of bulb-outs. The other concept is the standard city street section. There will be an exhibit map showing a schematic of the proposed improvements for both concepts which will include locations and widths of new driveway entrances. This project also includes new underground storm drain facilities to alleviate existing drainage problems.

Both projects will also include water and sewer improvements to be constructed before the completion of the new paving.
