Sewer Work on Keough and Hobson Starts Soon

The City of Bishop project to replace sewers on Keough and Hobson Streets is expected to start the first or second week in May. The \$125,000 Keough and Hobson Sewer Improvements project will replace deteriorated sewer mains and laterals on Keough Street east of Home Street and on Hobson Street between Keough Street and West Elm Street. The contractor on the project is Zenitram from Lancaster, California.

The new sewers will be constructed by trenching in the street. When sewer laterals are replaced, sewer shutoffs of up to several hours may be necessary. Sewer laterals are the private sewer pipes that lead from properties along the street to the city sewer main under the street. As much advance notice as possible will be provided to properties affected by shutoffs.

Parking will probably be restricted during the day Monday through Friday while work is underway and at other times when necessary. Construction materials, equipment, workers, and trenches in the street will require attention and will impact pedestrian and vehicle traffic. There will be ongoing lane and street closures and vehicle access to properties will be restricted at times. All efforts will be made to minimize the impacts and restrictions, but residents, drivers, and pedestrians should be cautious, take alternate routes when available, be alert for hidden hazards, and be patient with some inconvenience and with short delays.
