City Requests Hanby Stop Sign Comments

The City of Bishop invites comments on a proposal to change stop signs on Hanby Avenue in Bishop.

The proposal is to remove the stop sign on Hanby at Pine Street for traffic northbound traffic and add stop signs for both northbound and southbound traffic on Hanby at Willow Street. The proposal is shown on the attached sketch. The purposes of the proposed changes are to encourage traffic speeds appropriate for the residential neighborhood and to remove traffic restrictions where they might not be warranted.
