The Bishop Water and Sewer Commission is made up of Bishop citizens who meet every other month and act in an advisory capacity to the Bishop City Council and staff on water and sewer issues. Although knowledge of water and sewer systems is sometimes useful, it is not required. All that is required is an interest in getting involved in making city services better.

Both the water and sewer budgets are about \$1 million each year. The Commission gets involved in issues related to service, rates, improvements, customer concerns, and a lot of other things. Serving on the Water and Sewer Commission is an opportunity to be involved in these things in a positive way.
