Bishop Project A Construction Update 8

Work is progressing toward project completion the middle of next month on the City of Bishop street improvement project called "Road Improvement Project A".

Concrete work is expected to be complete next week at the Short Street location and water line work is expected to be complete at the North Third Street location. Storm drain and grading for concrete work is expected to start at the North Third Street location next week. Once all the concrete is in place at both locations, the streets will be paved. Once paving is done, there will be just a few items of work left to wrap up construction of the project including the distribution of 60 new trees to property owners affected by the project.

The numerous inconveniences of construction will continue until work on the project is complete. Parking will be restricted during the day Monday through Friday while work is underway and at other times when necessary. Equipment, workers, and trenches in the street will require attention, impact traffic, and restrict access to properties at times. Access to driveways will be restricted during concrete construction and concrete cure times. During concrete construction and curing, vehicles won't be able to get in and out of driveways. Access to walkways will also become more difficult as concrete work proceeds. There will be ongoing lane and street closures. All efforts will be made to minimize the impacts and restrictions, but residents, drivers, and pedestrians should be cautious, take alternate routes when available, be prepared to park and walk longer distances than normal, be alert for hidden hazards, and be patient with some inconvenience and with delays. Short water shutoffs to individual properties will also be required during construction for a few more days.
