Warren Street Improvements Project

The City of Bishop is starting to plan its next big street project, the Warren Street Improvements project. Because it is located in the downtown commercial core, this project should be important to all businesses and residents, and even to visitors.

The Warren Street project is generally planned to improve the full length of Warren Street with new pavement, curb, sidewalk, street trees, street lights, and other improvements. If there is enough money, the blocks of the side streets between Warren and Main streets will also be improved. The side streets are South, Lagoon, Church, Academy, Pine, and Elm. The money for the project comes from state and federal gas taxes.

At the current phase when planning work is started on a project, it is much easier to make changes. Once construction begins, anticipated in 2014 for Warren Street, it is too late to make meaningful changes. The city invites any and all feedback now so there will be the best chance to incorporate it in the final project. To gather the feedback, the city anticipates public meetings, a focus group of individuals willing to get involved in shaping the project, and other means. The focus group is expected to work throughout the life of work on the project. The first public meeting is anticipated around 1 May.
