Pine to Park Path Meeting

There will be a public meeting on Tuesday, 18 June 2013 to discuss the Pine to Park Path project. The meeting will be from 5:30 to 7:00 p.m. in the City of Bishop conference room at City Hall. The purpose of the meeting is to provide information on the project and to obtain input on the proposed improvements.

The Pine to Park Path project will construct an approximate 1,000 foot long paved pedestrian and bicycle path. The path would extend from the north end of an existing alley north of East Pine Street and east of North Third Street past the Bishop Community Garden to the existing paved path in the park near the intersection of Spruce Street. The project is to provide a safe, all-weather bicycle and pedestrian connection between the neighborhood located south of the park and Bishop City Park. The 14-foot wide path is proposed with 8-feet of paving and 3-foot unpaved shoulders. Drawings of the path are available on the city website and at City Hall and will be presented at the public meeting.

Work has been underway on environmental studies and on design of the project for several years. Construction of the path could be as early as spring 2014. The project is expected to cost about \$200,000 to construct.

It is expected the Bishop Parks and Recreation Commission will discuss the project at their July meeting to be held in the City Park. More information on this meeting will be released as it is available.
