COUNCIL PRESENTATIONS

Rescuers of Two Girls at the City Park Pond on January 19, 2007  
(1) Late in the afternoon on January 19, 2007 two young girls ventured out onto the frozen pond at the City Park and fell through the ice. From the nearby tennis courts Richard Everett Williams II and Bruce Alan Clark heard their screams, ran to their aid and pulled the girls from the cold water as the police unit arrived. Their actions resulted in the rescue of these girls from a very serious situation. The City Council presented these two men with several items in appreciation of their heroic action. Each received a city tile, a resolution from State Senator Roy Ashburn, a letter from Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger, and a centennial coin.

Mr. Corner reported that due to certain circumstances occurring this year a higher number of tractor trailers need to be stored on the fairgrounds. This is a situation that is temporary and will create a low impact to the parking lot.
