Mayor Crom announced that no action was taken on Agenda Item No. 1 relating to the appointment of a Police Chief.</p> <p>It was announced that action was taken on Agenda Item No. 2 relating to Public Employee Discipline/Dismissal/Release pursuant to Government Code Section 54957.1(d).</p> <p>The City Council considered in closed session an administrative appeal of a police officer on the Bishop Police Department from a decision of the Bishop Chief of Police terminating that officer’s employment and from a decision of first level administrative appeal by the City Administrator upholding the termination.
