PUBLIC HEARING

- (3) Pine to Park Path – Environmental Review on an Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration to construct an approximately 1,100 foot-long paved pedestrian and bicycle path to provide a safe, all-weather connection to the City Park for the neighborhood located to the south. The alignment of the path was modified to address public concerns and resulted in further environmental review and revision to the original Initial Study in 2009.
