Parks and Recreation Commission Minutes

August 29, 2007

CALL TO ORDER: The Parks and Recreation Commission met on August 29, 2007, the meeting was called to order at 5:15 p.m. in the City of Bishop Council Chambers.

STAFF REPORT: 1. The Commission received a copy of the co-ed softball standings and a copy of the men's league tournament. An end of season meeting with team managers will be scheduled to review the past season and discuss next season.

2. Adams Pool Solutions was the sole bidder for the pool replastering project at \$112,941.00. The project should start in the next couple of weeks.

3. At the next City Council Meeting will be requesting to bid for a surveillance system for the City Park at the September 10, 2007 meeting. Once a surveillance system is in place then we will be able address the issues of the bikes in the skate park and having the rules enforce.

Commissioner Hallenbeck inquired how the Police would monitor the skate park. Director Caldwell advised that the camera would be mounted outside the skate park. The system will be connected to internet and sent to the Police Department.

Working on having Civic organizations to purchase safety equipment for the kids. Commissioner Simpson suggested that we should ask the kids what they specifically would like in equipment.

4. The Park Pool closed August 19, 2007 due to the start of school and the Pool Replastering Project. Next year there is a possibility that the pool could stay open longer with the help from senior lifeguards.

5. We now have agency status with CPRS. All the full time employees along with the Commissioners and Council members are now members. You will be receiving a professional magazine that includes ideas for park designs and educational seminars.

6. Kellie Hallenbeck has been reappointed as Commissioner for Parks and Recreation for another term.

7. Election of officers are over due. This can be done at the next meeting.

8. September meeting we will invite members of the different organizations to express what they would like to see in the 5 Year Master Plan.

ITEMS FROM THE COMMISSION: Commissioner McDermott advised that the tennis court fence is needs some work around the perimeter. Director Caldwell will advise park staff.

Commissioner Simpson requested that next time the schools work on a grant that the City could be involved.
