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PUBLIC WORKS REPORT FEBRUARY 2006

WATER

1. Constructed a 4" Ductile Iron water service for the J-Diamond Mobile Ranch
2. Replaced faulty curb-stop valves at the following locations:
 - ◆ 451 Short Street
 - ◆ 207 West South Street
 - ◆ 301 North Fowler Street (for the new High School Administration Building)
3. Took routine monthly and weekly water samples
4. Took monthly readings of water meters.
5. Began formulating specifications for (PVC) Polyvinyl Chloride Pressure Pipe.
6. Painted the floor at Well #2.
7. Began the request for proposal process for a Water & Sewer Master Plan and Well #1 testing.
8. Installed valve-boxes at the following locations:
 - ◆ 515 North Third Street
 - ◆ 301 North Fowler Street
 - ◆ 207 West South Street
 - ◆ 451 Short Street

SEWER

1. Constructed a new 4" sewer lateral at 250 Clarke Street.
2. Cleaned plugged sewers at the following locations:

- ◆ 563 Home Street (roots)
 - ◆ 300 block of East Line Street (rags and paper)
 - ◆ 750 Keough Street (roots)
 - ◆ The intersection of North Main and Yaney (grease)
3. Continued with sludge reduction program.
 4. Cleaned sludge and grit drying beds.
 5. Irrigated City of Bishop 40 acre pasture.
 6. Performed grounds maintenance at the Waste Water Treatment Plant.
 7. Made repairs to Sewer Rodder truck.
 8. Made routine inspections of grease interceptors.

STREETS

1. Continued with annual Crack Seal program. The following streets have been completed.
 - ◆ West Yaney, Sierra, Crosby, Lee, Coats, Chamberlain, Kelso, Sycamore, Maple
2. Patched assorted potholes and cross-gutters.
3. Repaired and or replaced various street signs.
4. Swept city streets and alleys.
5. Inspected the construction of new curb, gutter and sidewalks at High Country Lumber.

MISCELLANEOUS

1. Assisted Park staff with snow removal in the Sunrise Mobile Home Park.
2. Provided weekly Tailgate safety meetings for all Public Works field staff.
3. Performed routine maintenance and made minor repairs to light trucks and heavy equipment.
4. Cleaned weeds and trash from shop planter

5. Assisted the Department of Water & Power in finding a solution to the ponding at the end of East Pine Street.
