Request For Bids

Pickup Truck

General: The City of Bishop requests bids for the purchase of a pickup truck. The truck will be used in and around Bishop on city streets and off road for a variety of public works purposes. Bids shall be delivered to Bishop Public Works at City Hall at 377 West Line Street, Bishop, California 93514, publicworks@ca-bishop.us. Bids shall be accepted until 3 pm on the close date of this request and shall be clearly identified "Pickup Truck Bid".

Purchasing Preferences: City of Bishop contracting preferences apply to this purchase. The city provides a preference to small and local businesses in accordance with Section 3.26 of the Municipal Code.

Requirements:

1. Year shall be 2014 or newer
2. Engine shall be gasoline, 6.2 Liter or equal
3. Drive shall be 2 wheel drive, single rear wheel
4. Transmission shall be heavy duty automatic
5. Truck shall be equipped with a 9 foot utility bed with ladder rack
6. Truck shall be equipped with a tow package and be capable of towing a minimum of 12,500 lbs maximum trailer capacity
7. Truck shall come with an installed pintle type hitch
8. Cab shall be standard 2 door regular cab
9. Seats shall be heavy duty vinyl covered

10. Flooring shall be vinyl covered
11. Truck shall have factory installed air conditioning
12. Truck shall have a back up alarm
13. Truck shall have a mounted Whelen or equal LED light bar amber in color visible from all sides of the truck
14. Truck exterior shall be white in color
15. Delivery of truck shall be no later than 1 September 2014
16. Truck shall have warranty of 3 years or 36,000 miles
17. Truck shall be equipped with manual windows and door locks
18. Truck shall have power steering
19. Truck shall be equipped with standard gauges

Bid Requirements:

The bid shall reference and include all documentation necessary to demonstrate minimum requirements are met. The bid cost shall be the total cost of the truck, including all applicable taxes and fees, delivered to the City of Bishop at a convenient location within the city limits.

If small business contracting preference is claimed, bid shall be accompanied by the bidders California Small Business number. If local business contracting preference is claimed, bid shall be accompanied with the attached form, completed by the bidder.
