## Public Works Report

January 2015

### Water

1. Removed various main line valves and fittings on Warren Street 4 inch main and abandoned it.
2. Repaired water level target on the Control Tank.
3. Marzano and Sons Construction completed work on the Warren, South and Academy Streets Utility Improvements Project.
4. City Forces assisted Marzano Construction with Main Line water shut downs.
5. Continue working with Terra Verde to implement solar power at Wells 2 and 4.
6. Performed grounds maintenance at Wells 2 and 4 as well as the tank site.
7. Took monthly readings of all water meters.
8. Took routine bacteria samples.

### Sewer

1. Provided daily monitoring of the Pilot Project.
2. Marzano Construction completed sewer main work on Warren, South and Academy Streets Utility Improvements Project.
3. Replaced a failed aerator on Pond 3 with a spare from our shop.
4. Made alterations to an existing repair on the sewer trunk line in the canal.
5. Installed a new manhole at the intersection of May and North Second Street.
6. Repaired one of the sludge pumps.
7. Videoed and evaluated sewer main lines that have not been reviewed in some time.
8. Performed routine maintenance to the Johnston Drive Lift Station.
9. Performed grounds maintenance at the Waste Water Treatment Plant.
10. Continued with the Collaboration effort with Eastern Sierra Community Services District.

11. Cleaned sludge drying beds.
12. Made routine inspections of grease interceptors.
13. Performed routine main line cleaning in trouble areas.
14. Responded to request for the placement of signs at the sewage ponds.

### **Streets**

1. Continued the process of replacing all street name signs within the city.
2. Assisted Eastern Sierra Propane with the lowering of a 2 inch gas line under North Warren Street. This work was done to accommodate the grinding and paving in the upcoming project.
3. Patched potholes in City streets that posed potential safety issues.
4. Repaired and or replaced damaged street signs.
5. Participated in Inyo Local Transportation Commission meeting.
6. Conducted pre-construction conference for Warren Street Improvements project.
7. Started construction of the Warren Street Improvements project.
8. Participated in meeting of the Warren Street Focus Group.
9. Met with Caltrans regarding permit requirements for storm drain construction across West Line Street as part of the Warren Street Improvements project.
10. Attended county's public hearing for the Eastern Sierra Adventure Trails.

### **Miscellaneous**

1. Began the process of removing trip hazards and failed pavement on the path within the City Park. Path is being replaced with concrete in these sections.
2. Performed maintenance and serviced Public Works vehicles
3. Provided weekly tail gate safety for the Public Works crew.
4. Hauled trash and debris from Fowler Pit to the Sunland Landfill.
5. Met with wiring contractor and Carmichael Business Technology about new network wiring in city hall.
6. Designed partial drainage improvement project for Sunrise Mobile Home Park.
