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Public Works Report

August 2015

Water

1. Replaced fire hydrant at the intersection of South Main and Mandich Street. Hydrant was hit by a semi-truck.
2. Relocated valves on Sunland Avenue to accommodate new sidewalk with the Inyo County Road project.
3. Completed annual main line valve exercising.
4. Continue working with Terra Verde to implement solar power at Wells 2 and 4. Participated in construction kick off meeting.
5. Performed grounds maintenance at Wells 2 and 4 as well as the tank site.
6. Took monthly readings of all water meters.
7. Took routine bacteria samples.
8. Responded to citizens' reports of water wasting.
9. Approved request to use city water for Inyo County construction project on Sunland Street.

Sewer

1. City of Bishop Public Works Crew began construction on the Sewer Pond Recirculation Project.
2. Replaced the methane gas mixer pump.
3. Cleared plugged sewer on North Fowler, between West Line and Church Streets.
4. Provided daily monitoring and made minor modifications to the Pilot Project.
5. Performed grounds maintenance at the Waste Water Treatment Plant.
6. Continued with the Collaboration effort with Eastern Sierra Community Services District.
7. Made routine inspections of grease interceptors.
8. Performed routine main line cleaning in trouble areas.

9. Continue working with Terra Verde to implement solar power at the sewer plant. Participated in construction kick off meeting.

Streets

1. Swept city streets and alleys.
2. Participated in Inyo Local Transportation Commission meeting.
3. Lead downtown Bishop parking open house.
4. Developed concept for parking in vacant lot at 794 North Main Street.
5. Participated in extensive media outreach concerning back-to-school and safety.

Miscellaneous

1. Assisted the Parks Department with design and removal of existing dirt infield at ball fields 1 and 2.
2. Replaced main hydraulic hose on sweeper.
3. Performed maintenance and serviced Public Works vehicles and equipment.
4. Provided weekly tail gate safety for the Public Works crew.
5. Hauled trash and debris from Fowler Pit to the Sunland Landfill.
6. Participated in Recreational Trails webinar about potential funding for city projects.
