THE 2016 DOWNTOWN BISHOP CHOCOLATE ART WALK

Now in it's 4th year, the **2016 Downtown Bishop Chocolate Art Walk** features thirty locations, dozens of artists & musicians, special art openings & musical performances, and free unique chocolate treats at every location. Many artists will be present at the various locations to share stories and insights about their work. Everyone is welcome, so please come out and enjoy the fun on Saturday, October 22nd, from 4:00 to 8:00 PM and help support your local artists, musicians and businesses during this entertaining, tasty, & stimulating evening!

(1) COONS GALLERY/SPOTTED DOG PRESS (2399 N Sierra Hwy. at Tu Su Lane) will be showing California oil paintings by **Richard Coons, Robert Clunie, & Wynne Benti**. Longtime Bishop resident **Ed Zdon**, originally of **Eddie & the Blue Notes** will be entertaining with with favorite polkas on his accordion including all time favorites such as the Clarinet Polka, the Italian Tarantella Wedding Dance, the Helena Polka and the Pennsylvania Polka. Chocolate brownies will be served.

(2) EASTSIDE ART HUB (2203 N Sierra Hwy. at See Vee Lane) will be showing upcycled glassware and romantically industrial furniture & lighting fixtures by **David Tidwell**, oil paintings by **Janice Kabala**, block prints by **Lori Michelon**, overpainted photographs by **Alex Stenzel**, photographs on canvas & acrylic (and books) by **Stephen Ingram**, metal sculpture by **Jael Hoffman**, ceramics & raku pottery by **Frances Cholewa & Tom Meyers**, fine woodworking & hand-crafted furniture by **Steven White**, soda-fired pottery by **Rena Hamilton**, and photography by **John Dittli**.

(3) CHRISTINA ROCKWELL, COMMUNITY ADVOCATE AND COORDINATOR (621 W Line Street, #205 in the Town and Country Center) will be showing paintings and drawings by **Rhondda Saunders**, and writings by **Chad Cathey**. Chocolate dipped strawberries will be offered.

(4) STEVEN WHITE WOODWORKING (336 Hammond St.) will be hosting an open studio. See the fine wood shop, a work in progress, and a gallery of furniture and fine wooden gift items. Steve will also have a display of types of joinery used in his furniture construction. And don't miss **Whiptail**, the outdoor sculpture behind the studio in the open lot on Academy Street.

(5) EASTSIDE JUICE (177 Academy Ave.) will be presenting *Eastern Sierra Collaborative Installation*, a pop-up exhibit of contemporary works from a collaborative of artists, showcasing the broad diversity of medium and talent in the Eastern Sierras. Artists featured include: **Laurel Stanford, Dana Ellis, Mary Matlick, Erin Boehme** and her grandmother **Dorcas Bircham, Lori Michelon, Janice Kabala, Rita Dushane-Jones, Lynn Marit Peterson, Kelly Turner, Karen Nielsen Licher, Bruce Licher, Eva Poole-Gilson, S. Thomas Kabala, Skandar Reid, and Judyth Greenberg**.

(6) LOONEY BEAN OF BISHOP (399A N. Main St.) will be showing photography by **Peter Stow** and **Don Smith**, paintings by **Kathleen Long** and **Rhondda Saunders**, and mixed media by **Patrick Haemerline**. Looney Bean Coffee Chocolate Bark will be offered.

(7) ANNE MARIE'S HOME BOUTIQUE (336 N Main St.) will feature weavings by **Cheryl Winstead**. Assorted chocolates will be offered.

(8) GYPSY KING TATTOO (324 N. Main St.) will be featuring a group show featuring artwork by **Weston Maddox** - Tattoo artist and mixed media artist, **Madison Hodges** - Tattoo artist and mixed media artist, **Daniel De La Riva** - Tattoo artist and watercolor artist, **Tia Cochran** - Mixed media artist, and **Ryan Harvey** - Hydro dip artist. There will be live tattooing and painting demonstrations, and they will be offering hot chocolate.

(9) LYONS LTD. JEWELERS (316 N Main St.) will be presenting new Eastern Sierra landscape paintings in watercolor and gouache by local artist **David Kirk**. Assorted chocolates will also be served.

(10) SAGE TO SUMMIT (312 N Main St.) will be featuring drawings and block prints by Eastside artist **Dallas Frederick**, whose current artwork has a conservationist message and deals with the intricate and fragile relationship between human development and the environment. A variety of chocolate treats will be served.

(11) THE PROJECT ROOM AT INDEPENDENT PROJECT PRESS (186-A Willow St.) will host the opening reception for *The Sacredness of Open Spaces*, an exhibit of beautiful encaustic mixed media paintings by **Rodney Thompson**, featuring layers of beeswax mixed with various earth pigments, tea bags and coffee grounds, among other natural materials. Also in The Project Room at Independent Project Press is the continuation of *Alternative Process Photographic Prints*, the current exhibit by well-loved Bishop photographer **Joe Profitta**, featuring new photographic work in a variety of vintage alternative processes including Platinum / Palladium prints, Cyanotypes, and silver prints distressed through the Mordencage process. In addition to these two exhibits, view a working letterpress print shop, along with Eastern Sierra oil paintings and prints by **Alan Sonneman** and **Ray T. Dutcher**. In the side parking lot outside of Independent Project Press will be a Raku Pottery Firing Demonstration by **Frances Cholewa** and **Tom Meyers** between 5 PM - 7 PM. Live musical performance by **SR2 (Bruce & Karen Licher)** at 7 PM in the print shop. Chocolate-dipped crystalized ginger and chocolate-dipped raspberries will be offered.

(12) KYLE HOLLAND & JASMINE AMARA POP-UP ART SPACE (outside Independent Project Press at 186-A Willow Street) will be presenting *Water & Time, The Power of Seeing*, a collaborative visual experience featuring photography by **Jasmine Amara** and **Kyle Holland**. Both Owens Valley born, Jasmine and Kyle draw inspiration from humanity's relationship with water. Taking the viewer on a spiritual journey, exploring birth, life and death in a high desert landscape, and possibly in another dimension. While raising important questions about our impact on the environment, this unique photographic experience also celebrates the camera's ability to preserve fragile fleeting moments. On display one night only, during Bishop's Chocolate Art Walk next to Independent Project Press at 186A Willow Street, we hope to see you there.

(13) IMAGINE THAT CREATION BY AIME (336 High St. just off Willow) will feature a wide range of artistic creations combining love for art, nature, creativity and preserving mother Earth, as they inspire **Aime** in all her artistic "creations." Step inside the private, appointment only, tattoo studio of **b1Exclusive/Chris Witty** and see Imagine that Creation's assortment of desert glass suncatchers, desert bottles and unique, one of a kind gifts. Last year's featured, (and raved over) homemade artisan chocolate creations, are also returning with opportunities to purchase them this year. Chocolate Cayenne Pumpkin seeds, Peppermint Chocolate pretzels, Caramel Chocolate Hemp hearts... Come nab them before they are gone. Limited amounts are to be made.

(14) HULA HALAU O'KORU (133 East Line Street in the alley parking lot behind Ben Franklin Crafts and next to Rite Way Pool and Spa in the Elks parking lot) will be presenting hula dancing demonstrations every 15 minutes. **Robert Nalumaluha** and **Jim Lambert** will be playing acoustic guitar and accompanying the dancers on a few numbers. **The Acapella Quartet** women's four part harmony group from the **High Sierra Chorus** will also be singing. Beginner class information and registration will also be available. Hawaiian Chocolate Bread Pudding will be served.

(15) FREE FORM WOODWORKING STUDIO & MICRO GALLERY (125 Whitney Alley #C) features original watercolor paintings from **Debb Campbell** and **Lynn Marit Peterson**, original ceramics by **Ron & Nancy Overholtz**, raku ceramics by **Tom Meyers**, original knitwork by **Laurel Profitta**, original artwork by **Karl Zellner** and **Laurie Morrow**, aluminum prints and original oil paintings by **Karen Nielsen Licher**, black & white desert photography by **Bruce Licher**, and hardwood inlay sculptures, pyrographics on pine, pen & ink and pyrography prints from **John & Gina Webber**.

(16) SIERRA COTTONS & WOOLS (117 E Line St.) will be presenting artwork by **Heather Freeman** of **Wild Onion Creations**. Heather will be showing her hand-crafted bags, scarves, wall hangings and home decor pillows inspired by nature and the wild and scenic Eastern Sierra. And find out about her upcoming sewing classes if you have the notion to stitch up your own custom creations! Chocolate Cake-Pops will be offered.

(17) RANGE & RIVER BOOKS (206 N. Main St.) is pleased to feature the paintings of popular Bishop artist **Joy Niewald**, plus small glass pieces and cards by Olancho-based young artist **Noa Lish**, and the nature photographs of **Ron Orfii**. A number of other artisans sell regularly at our shop, and their wares are all available as well. **The Calico Quilters Guild** will be displaying the phenomenal sampler 2016 Raffle Quilt and selling raffle tickets here during the walk. Treats will include Cascade Glacier Death By Chocolate icecream samples, and other treats and drinks like spicy Chocolate Chai tea.

(18) EASTSIDE SPORTS (224 North Main St.) will feature watercolor paintings by **Kay Wilson**, whose paintings "depict the place where I live, the mountains, the desert, the life within the landscape." Also on display will be metal sculpture by Olancho-based artist **Jael Hoffman**. Assorted hard dark chocolates will be served.

(19) BLACK SHEEP COFFEE ROASTERS (232 N. Main St.) will be showing paintings by **Janice Kabala, Susan Greenleaf, and Pat Crowther**. A new permanent photo collage exhibit titled *History of Eastern Sierra Climbing* will be making it's debut during the Art Walk. **Gordon Wiltzie** will have an art show that is "mountain culture" themed and the Black Sheep itself will be having a coffee and craft beer tasting featuring our latest round of "Direct Trade" coffees. *Art on the Spot: Little Art for Little People* is a hands on kids art activity. Kids will have the option to hang their art right onto the wall for Chocolate Art Walkers to enjoy. The evening's live music will begin with local high school students **Arianna Pope, Lily Pederson** and **Abby Stoiber**, playing classical and modern movie/show music on cello and violin from 4-6pm. These young musicians are currently studying with the **Felici Trio**. Donations for this performance will go towards funding a music study trip to Germany. Freshly baked chocolate treats will be offered from the Black Sheep bakery staff.

(20) GOOD EARTH YOGURT (251 N Main St.) will be exhibiting photographs by **Madison Taylor**. We will be offering free samples of our chocolate frozen yogurt topped with yummy chocolate toppings. We will also have some special delicious treats from Mimis cookie bar for sale. You can also find our selection of frozen yogurt, wine, beer and pie available.

(21) BISHOP ART SUPPLY (125 N. (22) PAINT IT AWAY (103 N. Main St.) will be showing artwork from a variety of artists who have painted at recent Paint It Away sessions. Artist and Paint It Away proprietor **Cami Ellis** will be providing 1/2 Sugar Skull face painting, and Chocolate Cookies will be offered.

(23) TEA COZY ANTIQUES (115 W Line St.) will be featuring photographs by Bishop photographer **Neil Sliger**. Proceeds from any art sales will support Neil's niece, **Karly McCutcheon**, and her business **Peaceful Hearts Community Cooperative**. Karly is a Davidson Academy of Reno senior and she promotes local art in the Reno area (www.renophcc.com). Chocolate Tea will be served.

(24) VINTAGE VOGUE BOUTIQUE (125 W Line St.) will be featuring **Broken Spur**, consisting of all handmade, completely unique pieces by artist **Whitney Lee Bradley**. Whitney specializes in restoring antiques and creating new pieces all with love and evoking a country cottage charm with a vintage flare. Some of the items she will be showing and selling are handmade signs, furniture, horse shoe jewelry racks, crosses, seasonal pieces and more. We will be continuing our fall raffle through that night and offering a chocolate delight.

(25) ART & SOUL: THE GALLERY AT CHURCH ON MAIN (125 S Main St.) Sip a cup of cacao chai, munch choco-chili popcorn, create a simple clay print, and meet **Frank Hawkins**, contemporary artist and photographer. Each artist will be bringing a different chocolate treat to share!

(27) MOUNTAIN LIGHT GALLERY (106 S. Main St.) Come and enjoy Bishop's premiere art gallery featuring the photography of **Galen & Barbara Rowell**. We will have one of our great local jewelry artists **Norma Vedder** here with a display of her newest jewelry! Come out and meet Norma and grab some early handcrafted holiday gifts! The current featured artist exhibit is titled *Sequoia & Kings Canyon National Parks: Celebrating the Centennial Anniversary of the National Park Service*. Featuring works by: **Vern Clevenger, Londie Padelsky, Elizabeth Carmel, John Dittli, David Muench** and **Jerry Dodrill**. They also have a unique selection of one of a kind art from local ceramic,woodworking and jewelry artisans. Assorted chocolates will be offered.
