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Public Works Report

June 2016

Water

1. Relocated fire hydrant at the intersection of Main Street and East Line to accommodate a LADWP pole replacement and relocation.
2. Water consumption for the month was up 20% compared to June 2013.
3. Replaced failed curb stop valve at 237 East South Street.
4. Replaced failed curb stop valve at 659 Maple Avenue.
5. Serviced electric well motors.
6. Continued annual exercising of all main line and fire hydrant valves.
7. Performed grounds maintenance at Wells 2 and 4 as well as the tank site.
8. Took routine bacteria samples.
9. Participated in Inyo Mono Integrated Regional Water Management Group meeting.

Sewer

1. Met with the Lahontan Region managers to discuss nutrient removal and enhanced irrigation.
2. Repaired broken sludge pump and performed maintenance on them.
3. Performed semi-annual maintenance on the aerators.
4. Cleaned main line sewers in Aspendel per our agreement with Inyo County.
5. Irrigated the 40 acre Sewer Pond Pasture.
6. Performed grounds maintenance at the Waste Water Treatment Plant.
7. Continued with the Collaboration effort with Eastern Sierra Community Services District (ESCSA).
8. Made routine inspections of grease interceptors.

9. Performed routine main line cleaning in trouble areas.
10. Took soil samples from the 40 acre pasture in various areas and sent them to the lab. These results will guide us as to what to plant to increase nutrient uptake.
11. Continued work on Sewer Trunk Replacement project.

Streets

1. Constructed a new cross gutter at south side of Clarke Street at the Sneden Street intersection.
2. Removed and replaced approximately 30 lineal feet of curb and sidewalk adjacent to 730 Home Street. Sidewalk was damaged by thermal expansion.
3. Continued spraying weeds in city streets and parking lots.
4. Continued traffic painting operations throughout town.
5. Patched potholes and gutters in city streets.
6. Participated in Inyo Local Transportation Commission meeting.
7. Met with Inyo County staff regarding North Sierra Highway Corridor Study.
8. Interviewed consultants for the Spruce Yaney Hanby Sidewalks project and selected Triad Holmes.
9. Finalized contract with NCE for municipal drainage planning.
10. Began work on application for Active Transportation Program funding for Academy Fowler Pine Sidewalks project.

Miscellaneous

1. Installed electrical conduits, pull box and water service at the Talmage Park restroom site. This work was outside of the scope with Clair Construction contract.
2. Provided traffic control for the Bishop High School graduation.
3. Attended Workers Compensation training provided by CJPA.
4. Cleaned up the yard at the Corporate Shop.
5. Provided weekly tail gate safety for the Public Works crew.
6. Hauled trash and debris from Fowler Pit to the Sunland Landfill.
7. Participated in Eastern Sierra Energy Foundation teleconference and met with staff.

8. Participated in training on 2015 Caltrans Standards.
9. Met with Toiyabe Indian Health Project staff concerning potential bike share program for Bishop area.
10. Participated in Eastern Sierra Energy Initiative teleconference.
11. Continued design of a project to construct a new path in the front of the park.
12. Met with proponents of proposed "Highball" event planned for fall.
13. Worked with Inyo County regarding possibility of cooperating on building permitting and inspection services.
14. Met with the courts regarding proposed facility on Wye Road.
15. Participated in building inspector interviews for Inyo County.
16. Worked on energy efficiency proposals with Ecogreen.
17. Worked to update Information Technology support contract for city.
