Public Works Report

July 2016

Water

1. Jim Moffett attended the USC Backflow course and successfully completed his certification.
2. Water consumption for the month was down 10% compared to July 2013.
3. Continued annual exercising of all main line and fire hydrant valves.
4. Performed extensive grounds maintenance at Wells 2 and 4 as well as the tank site.
5. Took routine bacteria samples.
6. Participated in Inyo Mono Integrated Regional Water Management Group meeting.

Sewer

1. Irrigated the 40 acre Sewer Pond Pasture.
2. Performed extensive grounds maintenance at the Waste Water Treatment Plant.
3. Continued with the Collaboration effort with Eastern Sierra Community Services District (ESCSA).
4. Made routine inspections of grease interceptors.
5. Performed routine main line cleaning in trouble areas.
6. Met with City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (DWP) staff about the possibility of improving drainage on DWP property near the wastewater treatment plant.
7. Began work on project to divert treated effluent from the Eastern Sierra Community Service District into Pond 4 for storage and improved irrigation.
8. Responded to concerns about wash rack near Wye Road.

Streets

1. Removed weeds and debris from City parking lots and alleys.
2. Continued spraying weeds in city streets and parking lots.

3. Cleaned ditch on Yaney along the Park.
4. Completed traffic painting operations throughout town.
5. Patched potholes and gutters in city streets.
6. Participated in Inyo Local Transportation Commission meeting.
7. Began work with NCE for municipal drainage planning.
8. Began work on application for Active Transportation Program funding for Academy Fowler Pine Sidewalks project.
9. Continued work to acquire right of way for the Seibu to School Path project.
10. Participated in North Sierra Highway Corridor Plan effort.

Miscellaneous

1. Provided cones and barricades along Spruce Street and Wye Road for the Fourth of July fireworks show.
2. Provided weekly tail gate safety for the Public Works crew.
3. Hauled trash and debris from Fowler Pit to the Sunland Landfill.
4. Participated in Eastern Sierra Energy Foundation teleconference and met with staff.
