This document is updated annually. This document contains all Enterprise Systems which are maintained by the City for the core services which we perform. For the purposes of this document, an Enterprise System is defined as a system of record. Also in accordance with 6270.5, this catalog

- (A) Information technology security systems, including firewalls and other cyber security systems.
- (B) Physical access control systems, employee identification management systems, video monitoring, and other physical control systems
- (D) Systems related to 911 dispatch and operation or emergency services.
- (E) Systems that would be restricted from disclosure pursuant to Section 6254.19. of the Government Code
- (F) The specific records that the information technology system collects, stores, exchanges, or analyzes.

Nothing in this section shall be construed to permit public access to records held by an agency to which access is otherwise restricted by statute or to alter the process for requesting public records, as set forth in this chapter.
