

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT
MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR
PINE TO PARK PATH
AND
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in keeping with CEQA an Initial Study has been completed and a Negative Declaration has been prepared to construct an approximately 1,100-foot-long paved pedestrian and bicycle path. The purpose of the project is to provide a safe, all-weather bicycle and pedestrian connection between the neighborhood located south of the park and Bishop City Park. The path would extend from the north end of an existing alley just north of East Pine Street and midway between north Third Street and north Second Street to the existing paved path in the park near its intersection of Spruce Street. The current lack of access between these streets requires park visitors to take longer, less desirable routes, to forgo trips to the park, or drive to the park. This project initiated in July 2009; however, the alignment of the path has been modified to address concerns raised by the public resulting in further environmental review and revision to the original Initial Study (IS).

The Initial Study may be inspected in the Public Works Department at 377 West Line Street, Bishop, and will be considered by the City Council of the City of Bishop on Monday, October 24th at 7:00 P.M. in the Bishop City Council Chambers, 301 West Line Street, Bishop, California.

The City of Bishop will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, October 24th at 7:00 P.M. to hear and consider citizen input on the above mentioned project.

If you challenge the findings, determination or decision made on the Initial Study in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the Public Hearing.

In compliance with Section 15072 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, notification is hereby given that the City of Bishop intends to adopt the proposed Negative Declaration.
