Request For Bids

One Half Ton Truck

General: The City of Bishop requests bids for the purchase of a one half ton truck. The truck will be used in and around Bishop on city streets and off road for a variety of public works purposes.

Bids shall be delivered to Bishop Public Works at City Hall at 377 West Line Street, Bishop, California 93514. Bids shall be accepted until 1500 15 September 2006 at City Hall and shall be sealed in an envelope marked "One Half Ton Truck Bid". The City intends to purchase the truck from the bidder with the lowest responsive bid.

Minimum Requirements:

1. The truck and all of its components shall be new.
2. The truck shall be a standard pick up.
3. The truck shall be two wheel drive.
4. The truck shall have a one half ton carrying capacity.
5. The truck shall have a 125 inch wheel base.
6. The truck shall have an installed 6.5 foot long tool box mounted longitudinally in bed.
7. The truck shall be powered with a 4 liter electronically controlled fuel injected gasoline engine.
8. The truck shall have a four speed automatic transmission.
9. The truck shall have a 3.73:1 limited-slip differential.

10. The truck shall use 17 inch wheels and shall be equipped with all weather tires.
11. The truck shall have installed front and rear bumpers.
12. The truck shall have air conditioning.
13. The truck shall have a 40% - 20% - 40% split cloth seat.
14. The finish of the truck shall be white.
15. The truck shall be delivered within 60 days of the opening of bids.

Bid Requirements:

The bid shall reference and include all documentation necessary to demonstrate minimum requirements are met. The bid cost shall be the total cost of the truck, including all applicable taxes and fees, delivered to the City of Bishop at a convenient location within the city limits.
