## **Public Works News Release**

### **MacIver Street Project Meeting**

The City of Bishop will hold a meeting to discuss the MacIver Street Improvements project on Thursday, 3 May 2007. The meeting will be at 7 pm in the City of Bishop Auditorium at the northeast corner of West Line Street and Fowler Street. Everyone interested in this important street project should attend.

The \$1.1 million MacIver Street Improvements project is planned for construction this fall and will extend MacIver Street, including sidewalks, planter strips, and utilities, to Spruce Street. On the existing street the project will replace sidewalk, driveways, and ramps and will construct new sidewalk, driveways, and ramps so there is continuous disabled-accessible sidewalk from North Main Street to Spruce Street. Drainage and water quality will also be improved.

A map showing project improvements will be displayed at the meeting. Also, City of Bishop staff involved in the project will be there to answer questions about the project and to hear your ideas and thoughts.

Funding for the construction of project is expected from several sources including the Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP), Transportation Enhancement (TE), Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and Federal Earmark. A number of agencies are involved in providing and administering each of these funding sources including the Inyo Local Transportation Commission, Caltrans District 9, California Housing and Community Development, Federal Housing and Urban Development, Federal Highways, and Inyo Mono Advocates for Community Action. Congressman Buck McKeon played an essential role in obtaining a major portion of this funding. Right of way for the project is being acquired from the City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power.
