## **Public Works News Release**

### **South Second Street Construction Starts Soon**

Construction of the South Second Street Improvements project is expected to start March 9<sup>th</sup> and last about two months. The project will remove trees, replace some water and sewer lines, construct new curb, gutter, and sidewalk, reconstruct the pavement, and provide replacement trees on South Second Street. The improvements will be made on the full length of South Second Street between South Street and Line Street and will include portions of Clarke Street and Short Street near Second Street. The project is expected to cost just over \$700,000 and is funded with state gas tax and city water and sewer funds.

The construction contractor on the project is V and C Construction out of Minden, Nevada. The contractor plans to start the second week of March with sewer work and tree removal. That work will be followed with curb, gutter, sidewalk, and driveway removal and construction which is expected to be complete about the middle of April. Finally, the street will be repaved and other finishing work done. The contractor plans to complete the project about the beginning of May.

Parking will be restricted during the day Monday through Friday while work is underway. Equipment, workers, and trenches in the street will require attention and could impact traffic. All efforts will be made to minimize the impacts and restrictions, but residents, drivers, and pedestrians should be cautious, take alternate routes when available, be alert for hidden hazards, and be patient with some inconvenience and with short delays.

Short duration sewer and water shutoffs will be required during construction. Residents will be advised in advance of these shutoffs and their planning, cooperation, and patience will be greatly appreciated.

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
