South Second Street Construction Update 3

The first new sidewalk is in place on the South Second Street Improvements project and more sidewalk, in addition to curb, gutter, water, and possibly sewer work, is planned for next week.

Sidewalk has been constructed on both sides of South Second Street between East Line Street and Short Street. Next week sidewalk construction is planned to continue between Short Street and Clarke Street. While sidewalk construction moves forward, new curb and gutter, driveways, and curb ramps will be constructed on portions of the street where new sidewalk has already been constructed.

The new water lines constructed on Clarke Street and on Short Street are expected to be put in service next week. Putting these lines in service will require short interruptions in service while the water services to each house are moved to the new line.

Sewer work may resume next week but no further sewer shut offs are expected.

The \$700,000 South Second Street Improvement project will remove trees, replace some water and sewer lines, construct new curb, gutter, and sidewalk, reconstruct the pavement, and provide replacement trees on South Second Street between South Street and Line Street. The project also includes portions of Clarke Street and Short Street near Second Street. The project is expected to be complete about 1 May.

Parking will be restricted during the day Monday through Friday while work is underway. Equipment, workers, and trenches in the street will require attention and could impact traffic. All efforts will be made to minimize the impacts and restrictions. Residents, drivers, and pedestrians should be cautious in and near the construction site. They should take alternate routes when available, should be alert for hidden hazards, and should be patient with short delays.
