Seibu to School Bike Path Information Meeting

There will be two meetings on Monday, June 15, 2009 to present and discuss the Seibu to School Bike Path project. The first meeting will be at 6:00 p.m. in the Bishop Paiute Tribal Chambers at 50 Tu Su Lane. The second meeting will be at 7:30 p.m. in the City of Bishop Auditorium at City Hall. Anyone interested in the proposed bike path should attend one or both of these meetings.

The Seibu to School Bike Path project will construct a two-way "class 1" paved bike path – essentially a road just for bikes - within the Bishop Paiute Reservation and the City of Bishop. The new path will be about 2,100 feet long and will connect the east end of Seibu Lane off of See Vee Lane to the north side of the Elm and Pine Elementary Schools with connections into the school campuses and to the west end of Keough Street. The path will provide two 4-foot lanes with 1-foot paved shoulders and 5-foot unpaved shoulders for pedestrians and equestrians. The public is invited to come to the meeting to learn more about the project and to provide comments on the project.
