Hanby Construction Update

The final major work on a series of City of Bishop construction projects on Hanby Avenue is expected to be completed next week. Water and sewer construction on the street is essentially complete and placement of concrete and gravel base is mostly done. Concrete and base placement is expected to finish next Wednesday. The street is expected to be paved next Thursday and Friday, 8 and 9 July. The final pavement striping and other work is expected to be completed the following week.

The City of Bishop appreciates Hanby Avenue resident's and driver's patience with the inconveniences from the series of three construction projects along the street. Construction is always inconvenient and construction on Hanby has gone on longer than had been expected. The primary reason the construction has gone on longer is the sewer emergency project that interrupted work on the paving project. Inconveniences of the projects have included parking restrictions, equipment noise, dust, and detours.

The work that remains requires continued lane and street closures. Vehicle access to properties will continue to be restricted at times. All efforts will be made to minimize the impacts and restrictions, but residents, drivers, and pedestrians should be cautious, take alternate routes when available, be alert for hidden hazards, and be patient with some inconvenience and with short delays.
