Paving for Bishop Project A

The first new pavement on the City of Bishop street improvement project called "Road Improvement Project A" is expected to be placed next week. The contractor plans to remove existing pavement and repave the Short Street part of the project by the end of next week. The paving will complete major work at the Short Street location of the project.

Storm drain work is expected to be completed at the North Third Street location of the project and concrete work is expected to begin there next week. The concrete work there is expected to take about two weeks to complete. Water and sewer work is complete on the project. The entire project is expected to be complete by Mule Days weekend.

The numerous inconveniences of construction will continue until work on the project is complete. Parking will be restricted during the day Monday through Friday while work is underway and at other times when necessary. Equipment, workers, and trenches in the street will require attention, impact traffic, and restrict access to properties at times. Access to driveways will be restricted during concrete construction and concrete cure times. During concrete construction and curing, vehicles won't be able to get in and out of driveways. Access to walkways will also become more difficult as concrete work proceeds. Sidewalk areas will often be obstructed by concrete forms. There will be ongoing lane and street closures. All efforts will be made to minimize the impacts and restrictions, but residents, drivers, and pedestrians should be cautious, take alternate routes when available, be prepared to park and walk longer distances than normal, be alert for hidden hazards, and be patient with some inconvenience and with delays.
