Maintenance Worker

The City of Bishop Department of Public Works is recruiting for the position of Maintenance Worker. The Public Works crew is hard working, well respected, and very effective at what they do. If you think you can contribute to the City of Bishop Public Works team, we would like to hear from you.

An application and job description are available on the City of Bishop website www.cityofbishop.com on the Jobs page under Departments - Administration or at City Hall, 377 West Line Street.

The first step in the selection process is a written test. The test will consist of math, reading, and writing needed to perform in the position and to pass the certifications required by the position. Applications will only be accepted at the completion of the test. The test will be given just one day, on Wednesday, August 11, 2021. Test times are:

The tests will be at the Bishop Fire Department Training Facility at 960 Poleta Road. To get to the fire training facility, go east on East Line Street. After traveling 1.0 mile from Main Street, turn right onto paved access road. The facility is on your right in 0.2 miles. A map is attached for reference. Bring photo identification, pencil, eraser, calculator, and any reference material you need for the test.

The salary will range from \$4,065 to \$5,412 per month plus incentives and attractive benefits. In general, as a member of the Public Works crew, the Maintenance Worker performs a variety of tasks in the construction, maintenance, and operation of the City's water, sewer, and street systems, in addition to other tasks as required. The tasks are varied and assignments are often given on short notice. All members of the crew must be able to operate all equipment and tools used in the work and become familiar with all tasks performed by the crew. Typical tasks include repairing water leaks, clearing plugged sewers, operating water wells, operating water treatment facilities, operating waste water treatment plant, cleaning drainage facilities, repairing potholes, operating street sweepers, operating snow plows, placing and finish concrete, and performing a variety of related and supporting tasks. The Maintenance Worker has license and certificate requirements specified in the job description.

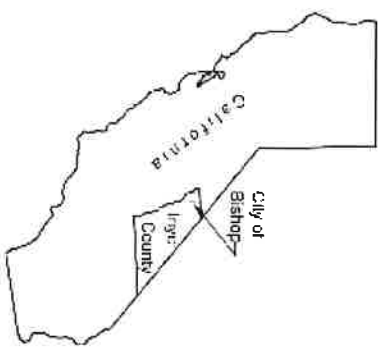
