Wye Road Work This Week and Next

The start date for the final work on the City of Bishop Wye Road Intersections Improvements project has been moved up to this Thursday 8 May. Work this week will include grinding pavement in preparation for paving next week. Paving is still planned for next Monday, 12 May.

Final work includes repaving a 300 foot long section of Wye Road and repaving the storm drain trench created from construction of the project. The repaving of the section of road is to address poor pavement in the area made worse by the construction of the project. The trench to be repaved is to address its rough surface.

Traffic on Wye Road can be heavy so the work will cause inconvenience and delays. Equipment, workers, and uneven pavement will require attention. All efforts will be made to minimize the impacts and restrictions, but drivers and pedestrians should be cautious, take alternate routes, and be patient.

The purposes of the project were to improve the safety and operation at the intersection and to improve drainage in the area. Funding for the project has been provided by the Kmart / Vons development and by Caltrans. The construction contractor is Marzano and Sons of June Lake. The engineering consultant on the project is Triad Holmes Associates of Bishop.
