## **Public Works News Release**

### **Park Path Construction Update**

Construction of the City of Bishop Pine to Park Path project is expected to start Monday, 9 June, and last 3 to 4 weeks. Visitors to the back of the Bishop City Park, including the Bishop Community Garden and Spruce Street near the Senior Center, should avoid the construction area, especially when work is underway.

The Pine to Park Path project will construct an approximately 1,000 foot long paved pedestrian and bicycle path. The path will extend from the north end of two existing alleys north of East Pine Street past the Bishop Community Garden to the existing paved path in the park near Spruce Street. The new path will be 8-foot wide with 3-foot unpaved shoulders. Path construction in the area of Spruce Street will include construction of sidewalk and on-street parking improvements.

The first week of work on the project is expected to include clearing the site, grading, and placing gravel base in preparation for placing concrete. The second week of work is expected to include placing concrete for the path and sidewalk. The final week of work is expected to include paving on Spruce Street near the Senior Center.

The \$200,000 project is funded by federal and state gas tax funds as well as funds from the Inyo Local Transportation Commission. The construction contractor is V and C Construction out of Minden, Nevada.

During the construction period, access to some parts of the park, including the Community Garden and Spruce Street, will be affected. It is expected that continuous pedestrian access will be available to the Community Garden, although gardeners are urged to avoid visits when the contractor is working. Care and patience from park and garden visitors is appreciated during the construction period.
