Mission Statement

To offer and promote recreational, educational and volunteer opportunities in fun, safe, well-maintained environment to persons of all ages, thereby promoting good health, teamwork and accentuating a positive quality of life.

Code of Conduct

The following code of conduct applies to individuals and organizations utilizing City of Bishop park and recreation facilities. The rights of certain individuals are protected by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Violations will be dealt with on a case by case basis.

I. Expected Behavior

- Be respectful and courteous to staff and other participants.
- Follow directions given by staff and their designee.
- Exhibit and maintain positive attitudes toward the environment.
- Exhibit and maintain respect of all property, facilities and equipment.
- Adhere to all facility rules and regulations.

II. Unacceptable Behavior

- Abusive language;
- Verbal threats;
- Physical violence;
- Obscene language or gestures, or possession of obscene or suggestive material or photos;
- Sexual misconduct, indecency, harassment;
- Any unlawful activity;
- Distribution or consumption of alcohol or drugs;
- Failure to cooperate with staff and/or leadership;
- Possession of weapons;
- Noncompliance with facility rules and regulations or City ordinances.

III. Discipline Policy

Noncompliance with this policy may result in the following actions;

At discretion of the staff and Youth Board, consequences may include:

- Verbal warning
- Written warning
- Expulsion from games or league
- Criminal charges
