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Public Works Report

May 2015

Water

1. Layne Company completed the installation of a new pump at Well 2.
2. Relocated fire hydrant at Sycamore Square to accommodate new driveway.
3. Cleared weeds and debris to create clearance around all fire hydrants.
4. Replaced SCADA PLC at the Storage Tank site.
5. Continued annual testing of all back flow valves within the city.
6. Continued annual main line valve exercising.
7. Continue working with Terra Verde to implement solar power at Wells 2 and 4.
8. Performed grounds maintenance at Wells 2 and 4 as well as the tank site.
9. Took monthly readings of all water meters.
10. Took routine bacteria samples.
11. Participated in Bishop Water and Sewer Commission meeting.
12. Participated in the Inyo Mono Region Water Management Group meeting for the first time as a full member organization.
13. Worked with Marzano and Sons to resolve a contract dispute related to the Warren Street Utilities project.
14. Gathered items for the time capsule proposed to be installed on Warren Street.

Sewer

1. Cleaned all main line sewers under Main Street and West Line Street.
2. Provided daily monitoring and made minor modifications to the Pilot Project.
3. Performed grounds maintenance at the Waste Water Treatment Plant.
4. Continued with the Collaboration effort with Eastern Sierra Community Services District.
5. Cleaned sludge drying beds.

6. Made routine inspections of grease interceptors.
7. Performed routine main line cleaning in trouble areas.
8. Met with Southern California Edison and their consultant concerning assistance improving efficiency of the aerators at the sewage ponds.

Streets

1. V&C Construction continued work on the Warren Street Improvement Project. At this time work is completed except the red concrete crosswalks.
2. Continued installing miscellaneous street signs along the Warren Street Project.
3. Installed new wheel stops in all parking lots affected by the Warren Street project.
4. Cleaned weeds and debris from all city parking lots in preparation of the Mule Days celebration.
5. Sprayed weeds on city streets and alleys.
6. Patched potholes in City streets that posed potential safety issues.
7. Repaired and or replaced damaged street signs.
8. Participated in Inyo Local Transportation Commission meeting.
9. Worked with the American Legion Auxiliary and Caltrans to install additional flags in sidewalks on city streets and state highways within the city.
10. Held public meetings to gain input on potential Active Transportation Program (ATP) projects.
11. Submitted application for ATP funds for the Spruce Yaney Hanby Sidewalks project.
12. Worked with proponents of special events to be held on city streets in preparation for issuing encroachment permits.
13. Participated in bike to work celebration at the City Park.
14. Installed drinking fountain in Talmage Park funded by the Toiyabe Indian Health Project and the Inyo Department of Health and Human Services.

Miscellaneous

1. Installed flag sleeves in the sidewalk at various locations. This work was done to assist the American Legion.
2. Assisted the Mule Days Association with traffic control and closures for the Mule Days parade.

3. Performed maintenance and serviced Public Works vehicles
4. Provided weekly tail gate safety for the Public Works crew.
5. Hauled trash and debris from Fowler Pit to the Sunland Landfill.
6. Met with Community Services staff concerning new restrooms in Talmage Park and near the Senior Center in the City Park.
