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Public Works Report

March 2016

Water

1. Performed grounds maintenance at Wells 2 and 4 as well as the tank site.
2. Took monthly readings of all water meters.
3. Took routine bacteria samples.
4. Responded to citizens' reports of water wasting.
5. Attended Inyo Mono Regional Water Management Group meeting.

Sewer

1. Southern California Edison commissioned the Solar Array at the Waste Water Treatment Plant. As of that day it is producing power.
2. Repaired failed culvert between ponds 2 and 3.
3. Burned tules on the Sewer Ponds.
4. Cleared plugged sewer at the intersection of North Fowler and Church Street.
5. Completed the Pilot Project study.
6. Hauled excess dirt from the back of the City Park to the Sewer Ponds Pasture.
7. Made various enhancements to the irrigation system at the 40 acre pasture.
8. Performed grounds maintenance at the Waste Water Treatment Plant.
9. Continued with the Collaboration effort with Eastern Sierra Community Services District. Discussed most recent report on effort.
10. Made routine inspections of grease interceptors.
11. Performed routine main line cleaning in trouble areas.
12. Continued work on the Sewer Trunk Replacement project in anticipation of construction during the winter of 2016/2017.

Streets

1. Constructed cross gutter at Sneden and Short Street.
2. Began spraying weeds in city streets and parking lots.
3. Patched potholes and gutters in city streets.
4. Participated in Inyo Local Transportation Commission meeting.
5. Started with preliminary design for the Academy Arch project.
6. Met to discuss update of Pavement Condition Survey.
7. Interviewed consultants for the Municipal Drainage Planning effort funded through the Inyo Local Transportation Commission. Selected NCE as the consultant.

Miscellaneous

1. All staff attended Discrimination and Harassment Training.
2. Assisted the Park Crew with cleanup of the undeveloped portion of the Park.
3. Provided weekly tail gate safety for the Public Works crew.
4. Cleaned up the Public Works Shop.
5. Hauled trash and debris from Fowler Pit to the Sunland Landfill.
6. Participated in processing of Bishop Nursery Tract Map 250.
7. Helped manage "red tag" property on Grove Street.
8. Participated in Eastern Sierra Energy Foundation teleconference and met with staff.
9. Met with representatives of electric utility companies on the Parks Restrooms project.
10. Attended Anti-Discrimination and Harassment training.
