General: The City of Bishop requests proposals for aerial image collection and provision services.

Purpose: The purpose of the project is to collect, process, and provide updated aerial imagery for use with the city's Geographic Information System (GIS) as well as for other purposes.

Scope: The general scope of the project includes all the work to plan, collect, process, and provide the aerial imagery in ortho-rectified and georeferenced electronic format that is suitable for use with current versions of ESRI GIS software. The scope of work outlined here could be modified up or down in such a way that the city would receive best value consistent with available funding.

Two sets of imagery with different resolutions are requested. The general areas are depicted on the attached map. The GIS data associated with the boundaries is available.

The areas that medium resolution imagery is desired amount to about 2,600 acres and the areas that low resolution imagery is desired amount to about 4,300 acres. There is a small overlap between the two areas.

Resolution for the medium resolution imagery should be 4 inches per pixel or better. The resolution for the low resolution imagery should be 6 inches per pixel or better.

The imagery should be captured the middle two weeks of March 2017.

Most details of the imagery, its collection, and provision will be determined by the successful contractor.

Proposal: A qualifying proposal must address the scope and include:

1. Brief description of firm, contact person, address, telephone number, and e-mail address.
2. Description of proposed imagery collection schedule, process, and equipment.
3. Detailed description of proposed imagery including how it would meet the stated purpose.
4. Proposed delivery date of complete imagery.
5. Description of quality control processes.
6. Three references at small rural agencies where firm has provided similar imagery.
7. Price delivered to Bishop, California.

Proposals must be received no later than 1500 (3 pm) on the closing date of this Request for Proposals (RFP). Send proposals to:



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Three paper copies and one electronic copy of the proposal clearly marked with the title of the RFP shall be submitted.

Selection and Contracting: The consultant will be selected based on the suitability of the proposed imagery for the city's purpose, references, and price.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive minor irregularities in said proposals, or to negotiate minor deviations with the highest rated firm.

It is expected the procurement will need to be approved by the City Council at one of their twice-per-month meetings. Contract provisions would include that the city would own full rights to its copy of the imagery and would include typical insurance provisions.




City of Bishop
