General: The City of Bishop requests bids for 5 new large doors and openers at Fire Station 1, located at 209 W. Line Street, Bishop CA. Photos are below.

Bids shall be delivered to Bishop Fire Department at 209 W. Line Street, Bishop, California 93514, or jdell@cityofbishop.com. Bids shall be accepted until 3 pm on the close date of this request and shall be clearly identified "Apparatus Doors Bid". For more information call 760-873-5485.

Purchasing Preferences: City of Bishop contracting preferences apply to this purchase. The city provides a preference to small and local businesses in accordance with Section 3.26 of the Municipal Code.

Details:

- Two 12 foot wide by 14 foot high doors.
- Three 12 foot wide by 12 foot high doors.
- The doors shall come equipped with Liftmaster Model H, $\frac{3}{4}$ horsepower, heavy duty jackshaft operators with constant contact on the "Close" button, or equivalent.
- The doors shall be red in color.
- Doors must be completed or openings secured against entry at the end of each day.

- Completed doors shall meet City of Bishop building standards.
- The city will provide building permit for the door at no cost to the vendor.
- Detailed shop drawings and colors shall be submitted and then approved by city before final order is placed.
- Bids shall include removing and disposing of existing doors, modifying openings, as needed, and furnishing and installing new doors.
- Bids shall include all taxes and fees.
- If small business contracting preference is claimed, bid shall be accompanied by the bidders California Small Business number. If local business contracting preference is claimed, bid shall be accompanied with the attached form, completed by the bidder. If no preference is claimed, nothing is required.
- Bids shall be accompanied by a proposed installation schedule.
