**NOW HIRING: LEVEL I RESERVE OFFICERS – CITY OF BISHOP,
CALIFORNIA**

Level I Reserve Police Officers perform respective law enforcement duties in a support role, under the general supervision of a Sergeant or designee. Duties include performing a variety of peace officer duties in the enforcement of laws, the protection of persons and property, crime prevention and suppression. Reserve Police Officers also have the opportunity to perform specialized assignments.

Requirements: Candidates must be a POST academy graduate, possess a Basic POST, or possess a POST Level I Training Certification, be 21 years of age, be in good physical condition, pass a thorough medical exam as well as an extensive background investigation. Candidates must be a citizen of the United States or a permanent resident alien who is eligible for and has applied for citizenship.

California Driver's License & Driving Record: Applicants must possess a valid California Class "C" driver's license and an acceptable driving record prior to and throughout employment.

Compensation: Reserve Level I Officers are paid \$35.00 per hour, up to a maximum of 1000 hours per year. The Department supplies all uniform equipment as well as provides on-going training to all sworn personnel.
