NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Bishop on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, for the following Officers and Measure:

For Three (3) Members of the City Council      Full term of four years

For a City Treasurer      Full term of four years

<b>BISHOP COMMUNITY SAFETY AND ESSENTIAL SERVICES MEASURE.</b> To provide the City of Bishop with funding to maintain essential services such as police, fire, street maintenance, and parks and recreation, shall an ordinance creating a one-cent transactions (sales) and use tax be adopted, providing approximately \$1.8 million annually until repealed by voters, with all funds locally controlled and independently audited?	<b>YES</b>

The nomination period for these offices begins on July 13, 2020 and closes on August 7, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

If nomination papers for an incumbent officer of the city are not filed by August 7, 2020 the voters shall have until the 83<sup>rd</sup> day before the election, August 12, 2020, to nominate candidates other than the person(s) who are the incumbents on the 88<sup>th</sup> day before the election, for that incumbent's elective office. This extension is not applicable where there is no incumbent eligible to be elected.

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by § 10229, Elections Code of the State of California.

The polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
