Seibu to School Path Construction Starts

Construction starts this week on the City of Bishop Seibu to School Path project and is expected to continue into early November. Work is expected to start with tree removal.

The \$400,000 Seibu to School Path project will construct a paved path from the west end of Keough Street to the west side of the Pine and Elm Street Elementary Schools. The improvements will include sidewalk on a portion of the north side of Keough Street and will include a connection into the north side of the schools. The project is funded from the state of California using gas tax funds.

Although the path was once planned to connect with Seibu Lane on the Bishop Paiute Reservation, the project has been shortened to only include construction within the city. The new paved path will not connect directly to Seibu but it will connect with existing and planned paths on the Reservation that will complete the connection to Seibu.

The 1,300 foot long path is planned to be 8 feet wide with 2 to 5 foot unpaved shoulders and will require the removal of Arizona Cypress trees along the north side of the schools. Mature willow trees in the area will be protected and trees will be planted to replace the removed trees.

Project construction may impact traffic on Keough Street west of Home Street at times. Equipment, workers, excavations, uneven ground, and other hidden hazards will require attention on and near the construction site, even when work is not underway.
