The City of Bishop Parks and Recreation Department will be closely monitoring the air quality this week to determine whether or not the pool will need to be closed due to unhealthy air quality. The public is advised to watch air quality levels as well. The City of Bishop will be monitoring the Bishop's air quality through Great Basin Unified Air Pollution Control District's website at www.gbuapcd.org. Should the air quality levels go into the "Unhealthy" red zone, the pool will not open, or will shut down temporarily and be monitored for an hour. If the air quality level improves during that hour, the pool will resume business and monitoring will continue. If the levels do not change or worsen, the pool will close for the remainder of the day. This is a precautionary health measure for both pool staff and the public.
