NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ON THE PROPOSED ADOPTION OF AN ORDINANCE
RELATING TO "ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS"
AND SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Bishop City Council will hold a public hearing on Monday, November 13, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 301 West Line Street, Bishop, California to hear and consider citizen input on a proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BISHOP, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADDING CHAPTER 15.14 ENTITLED "ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS" TO TITLE 15 "BUILDINGS AND CONSTRUCTION" OF THE BISHOP MUNICIPAL CODE, WHICH SETS FORTH PROCEDURES FOR EXPEDITING PERMITTING PROCESSING FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING SYSTEMS."

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE: This proposed ordinance will add Chapter 15.14 entitled, "ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS" to Title 15 "BUILDINGS AND CONSTRUCTION" of the Bishop Municipal Code, which sets forth procedures for expediting permitting processing for electric vehicle charging systems. The purpose of Chapter 15.14 is to promote and encourage the use of electric vehicles by creating an expedited, streamlined permitting process for electric vehicle charging stations while promoting public health and safety and preventing specific adverse impacts in the installation and use of such charging stations. Chapter 15.14 is also purposed to comply with California Government Code Section 65850.7.

Following the public hearing, the proposed ordinance will be reviewed for introduction, with the adoption of the ordinance scheduled for Monday, November 27, 2017.
