NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ON THE PROPOSED ADOPTION OF AN ORDINANCE
RELATING TO RETIRED COUNCIL MEMBER MEDICAL BENEFITS
AND SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Bishop City Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, October 11, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 301 West Line Street, Bishop, California to hear and consider citizen input on a proposed ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BISHOP, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, REPEALING AND REPLACING SECTION 2.04.031 OF THE BISHOP MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO RETIRED COUNCIL MEMBER MEDICAL BENEFITS."

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE: This proposed ordinance repeals and replaces Section 2.04.031 of Chapter 2.04 CITY COUNCIL of the Bishop Municipal Code to change the retirement medical benefits for City Council Members as follows: Council members who leave elective office shall be deemed to be retired officers and employees of the city of Bishop for all purposes after having served eight full years of council member service as an elected official with the city, and having reached a minimum of sixty-five years of age at the time they leave such position. These above requirements for medical benefits shall not be applicable to council members who were on the Bishop City Council as of November 1, 2016. Council members who were on the City Council as of November 1, 2016, are entitled to medical benefits if they have served two full terms or seven and one half years on the Council as an elected official with the city, and having reached a minimum of sixty-two years of age at the time they leave such position.

Following the public hearing, the proposed ordinance will be reviewed for introduction, with the adoption of the ordinance scheduled for Monday, October 24, 2016.
